




FRATERNITIES AGAINST THE F WORD





PRESENT DAY

OCTOBER 18, 2020

A mother posted on the QU Parents Facebook page about hateful acts that took place towards a student. An email was sent out involving the homophobic incident that sparked conflict.

STUDENTS' RESPONSE

Athena Cuttle, the 2020-2021 GSA president, had responded to the administration's statement and pushed for initiatives to explicitly discourage homophobic behaviors on campus.

STATEMENT

"We want the University of the Future to be a place where all identities are affirmed and respected [...]. As it stands now, we believe the university has not yet achieved such an environment. We hope that by making the changes listed above and engaging in dialogue with the Gender and Sexuality Alliance, the university will take meaningful steps toward a more inclusive community." -Taken from GSA's statement
